Our goal is to reduce our emissions to become a zero carbon footprint company. We are also utilizing new technologies to eliminate waste, from sewage to rubbish to medical waste and other end-use products that can't be recycled. It is a completely closed-loop lifecycle process that we hope the rest of the industry will also incorporate in the coming years.

The average person is responsible for the consumption of 3.78 gallons (6.9l) of gasoline per day. When adding in electrical power consumption, oil & gas heating, and residential natural gas usage, our vessels are in a better carbon footprint position than the land based equivalent.
